

Waking Up White: A Four-Week Book Discussion

Mondays, October 16, 23, 30, and November 6 2:00 p.m., Room 3, Mountain Shadows Church

Waking Up White, and Finding Myself in the Story of Race by Debbie Irving explores the author's efforts to understand racism and racial tensions, while offering a fresh perspective on bias, stereotypes, manners, and tolerance. Incorporating personal narrative and discussion questions, Waking Up White has been recommended by Revs. Denise Anderson and Jan Edmiston, the current Co-Moderators of the Presbyterian Church USA's General Assembly. Theses two leaders of our denomination co-authored the study guide that will shape our discussions of Waking Up White. Copies of the book will be available for \$15.00 apiece.
