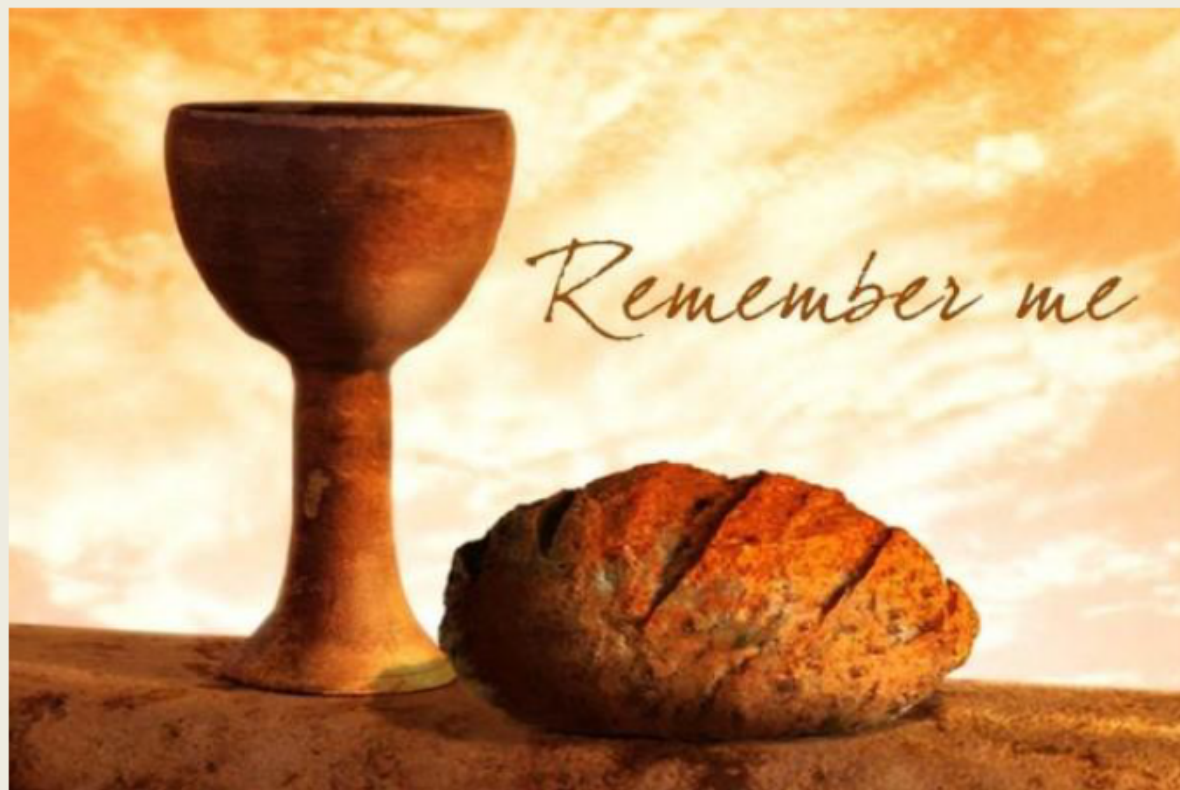

Call to Self-Examination before Communion (based on 1 Corinthians 11:27-31)
