## It's Skin Cancer Prevention Month at Mountain Shadows!

**USE YOUR HEAD** - Not all sun protection comes in a bottle. So it's smart to use your head when you are out in the sun. Up to 80% of skin cancers occur on the head and neck, so a wide-brimmed hat is a great way to shade your face, ears, scalp, and neck from the sun's rays. A hat with a four-inch brim provides the most protection.
