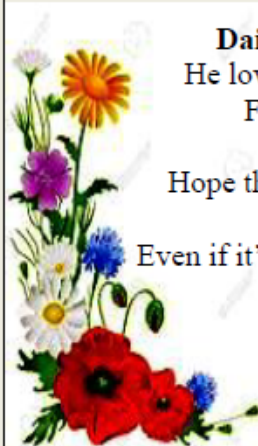

**“Three Billboards Outside Ebbing, Missouri” Discussion Group Coming July 30<sup>th</sup>!**

The film “*Three Billboards Outside Ebbing, Missouri*” won the 2017 Golden Globe awards for “Best Picture” and “Best Screenplay”, the 2017 Screen Actors Guild awards for “Best Cast Ensemble”, “Best Actress” and “Best Supporting Actor”, and the 2017 Academy awards for “Best Actress”, “Best Supporting Actor” and “Best Religious Film”.

The *Religious News Service* writes: “...the story itself is one of the most religious tales that you will see on the silver screen. ...The ultimate message of *Three Billboards Outside Ebbing, Missouri*: Given the right circumstances and the right kind of support and encouragement, deeply wounded people can engage in...the repair of their inner lives...and transform themselves, and become deeper, holier people”.
