

At the 226th General Assembly, a new “menu” of [Special Offerings](#) was approved, taking effect January 1, 2026.

Please take note of the new Special Offerings names and descriptions, particularly if you give to them online via the Presbyterian Foundation. The MSPC online “Give” page link has been updated to reflect these changes. Other options have not changed.

1) One Great Hour of Sharing — Offering season Feb. 18–April 5, 2026

- Traditionally received on Palm Sunday or Easter but can be received anytime during the *Lenten season*
- Causes supported: disaster, hunger, poverty, climate change, immigration, migration and refugees

2) World Communion Offering — Offering season Sept. 6–Oct. 4, 2026

- Traditionally received on World Communion Sunday but can be received anytime during *A Season of Preparation*
- Causes supported: racial justice, gender justice, peacemaking, global witness, ecumenical and interfaith relations
- As part of this Offering, a grant program is being created that allows any council of the PC(USA) — session, presbytery or synod — to apply for funds to support their own efforts to do ministry around these cause areas


The **Peace & Global Witness Offering** will transform into the **World Communion Offering**. There will be a new grant-making program to support local and regional ministries. Your congregation or mid council will be able to apply for a grant for your own ministries that align with the causes supported through this new Offering.

3) Christmas Joy Offering — Offering season Nov. 29–Dec. 19, 2026

- Traditionally received on the fourth Sunday of Advent or Christmas Eve but can be received anytime during the *Advent season*
- Causes supported: children-at-risk, youth and young adults, leadership development for people of color, Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color, servants of the Church in need through the Assistance Program of the Board of Pensions

The **Pentecost Offering** will be discontinued after the 2025 Offering. However, all current recipient causes will continue to be funded through the churchwide Special Offerings. Specifically, ministries focused on children-at-risk, youth, and young adults will now be part of the **Christmas Joy Offering**.
